The Real South Africa will take you to get a covid 19 test from an approved country provider before exiting the country for your next destination per protocol

Covid Screen Form to be completed upon arrival

All travelers must complete a covid screening form upon arrival and present a paper copy of a negative PCR test taken within 72 hours of arrival and keep a copy of it on your phone in the form of a PDF. It must be signed by the person who took the test. You should take several copies, in case you have to hand them over at different stages. Those arriving without a test are subject to quarantine at their own expense.

Screening is ongoing at all points of entry.

Transits are also allowed, though again you must present the same negative PCR test.

Your location of your accommodations needed to complete the form attached is listed on your itinerary.
